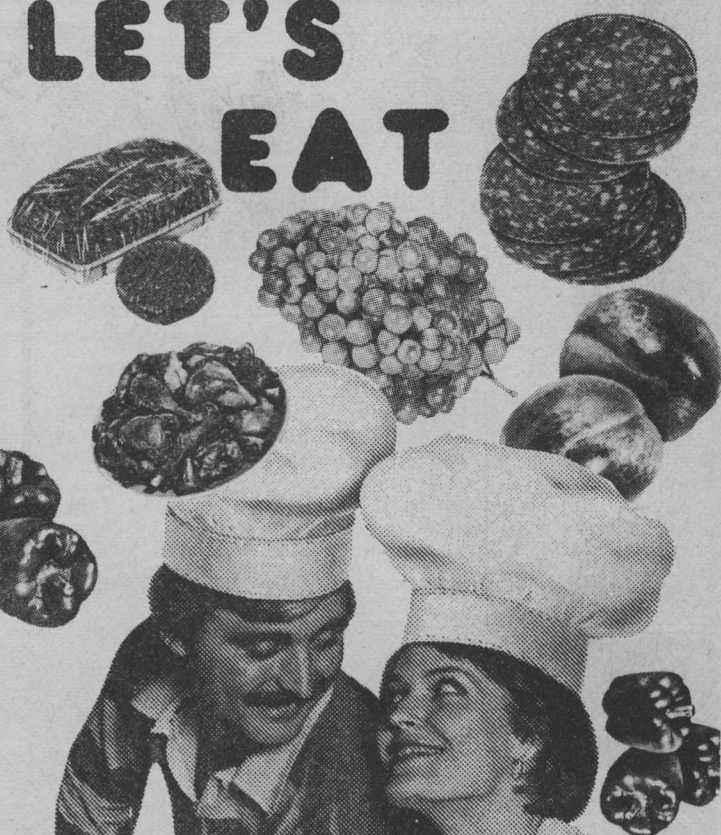




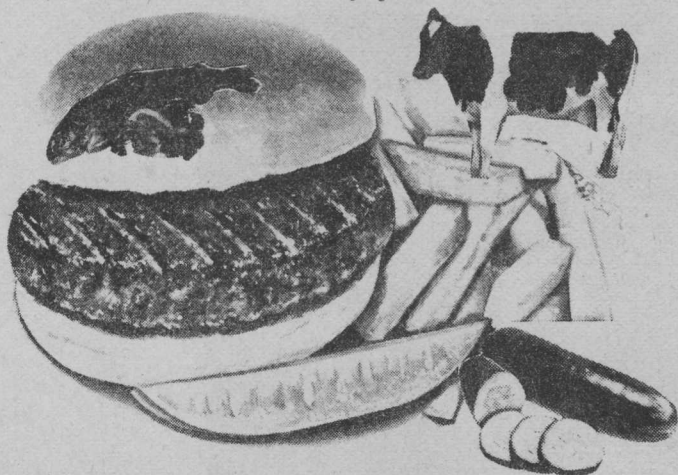
LET'S EAT

ROYAL CASTLE (125 ST. & NE 7th AV. N. MIA)---

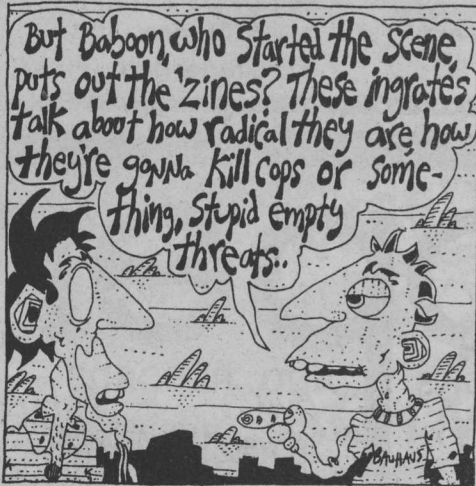
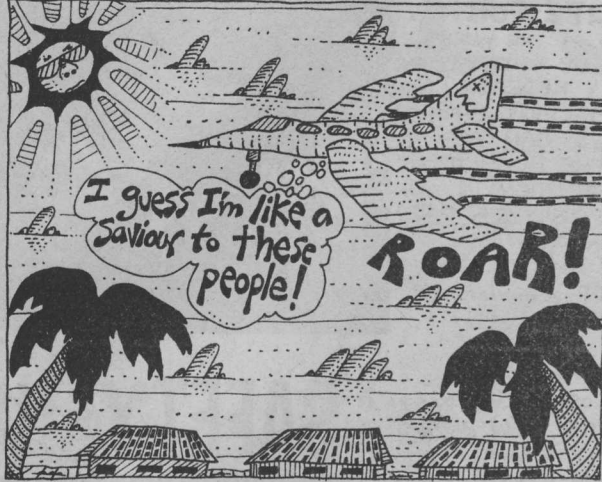

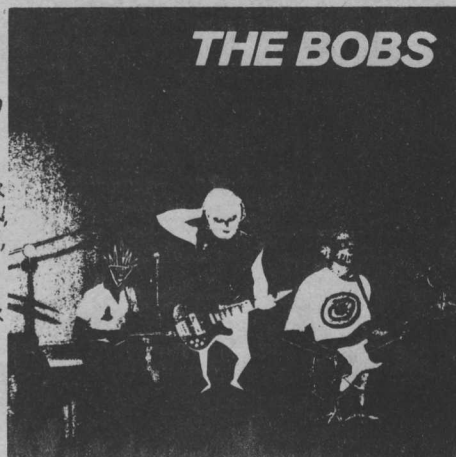
